## PART C: MEMBERSHIP & REGISTRATION DUES TERMS

I understand that by filling out this registration form and returning it with my first payment, I am entering into a contractual relationship with the Tiger Aquatic Club to remit all payment of all membership and registration fees associated with the specific program, session and days for which I have registered.

### Dues Remittance Schedule

Dues are billed on the 1st of the month and must be paid by the 10th of the month to avoid a \$20.00 late fee. Families that are routinely late in paying their dues will be required to pre-pay (prior to the 1<sup>st</sup>) or their child or children will not be allowed to swim. Escrow funds will not be refunded to a swimmer leaving the team. They will be treated as a general donation to the team.

I understand that the Tiger Aquatic Club will email or distribute membership dues invoices on or around the 25th of every month for program fees and meet fees will be posted at [www.tigeraquaticclub.com](http://www.tigeraquaticclub.com) and a copy will be in the TAC Office and must be paid prior to the meet start date. For more information on Financial Policies, please see Part D of this contract.

### Late Payments / Bounced Checks

I understand that a late fee of \$20.00 will be assessed for all dues remittance not postmarked prior to the due date. Additionally, I understand that failure to pay all outstanding dues within two weeks after the due date will result in suspension of membership until payment in full is received by the Tiger Aquatic Club. I also understand that all returned checks are subject to an additional \$20.00 charge.

### Collections

I understand that in the event I fail to remit all membership dues associated with the specific program, session and days for which I have registered, I will compensate the Tiger Aquatic Club for all expenses incurred by the Tiger Aquatic Club to collect such membership dues including, but not limited to: all attorney fees, court costs and associated collection fees.

### Refunds and Cancellations

I understand that the Tiger Aquatic Club has found it necessary to establish a firm **NO REFUND POLICY** concerning registration fees and program fees. The Tiger Aquatic Club financial commitments involve annual pool and staff contracts based on swimmer registrations at the beginning of each season. Therefore, I understand that the Tiger Aquatic Club provides **NO REFUND OF ANY REGISTRATION FEES OR PROGRAM FEES**. This policy covers and includes, without limitation, requests for refunds and/or cancellations as the result of any changes in the Tiger Aquatic Club personnel, including changes in the team's coaching or management staff.

## PART D: FINANCIAL POLICIES

- 1) Billing is done on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. Dues must be paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month to avoid a late fee of \$20.
- 2) Children of families 30 days in arrears on their account will not be allowed to swim until their account is up to date. Families will be notified that their account is past due by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month and will not be allowed to swim on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the next month without payment of current balance and next month's fees. (Example: a family misses its June dues payment by the 10<sup>th</sup> of June. By the 20<sup>th</sup> of June TAC will inform the family that it is in arrears. On the 1<sup>st</sup> of July the children will no longer be able to swim without payment of both June and July dues payment.
- 3) TAC will support partial monthly dues for a new swimmer or swimmers joining the team for the first time part way through a month. Swimmers starting the first week of the month will pay full monthly dues. Swimmers starting the second week will only be required to pay  $\frac{3}{4}$  of normal monthly dues. Swimmers starting the third week of a month will be charged  $\frac{1}{2}$  of normal monthly dues. Swimmers starting after the third week will be charged only  $\frac{1}{4}$  of normal monthly dues. This does not apply to quitting part way through a month or to rejoining the team.
- 4) Meet fees are due prior to participation in that meet. When a family submits a meet entry to the coach, our financial team will add their fees to their bill. These fees must be provided to the Head Coach or Team Treasurer prior to the meet. If fees are not submitted prior to the meet, the child or children will not be allowed to participate.
- 5) An account 90 days past due will receive a collection letter providing 30 days to pay the outstanding balance or be sent to collections. After 30 days, we provide documentation to our collection agency for processing. (BOARD NOTE: these policies are based on federal and state law. Action Collections is our collection agent and per nonprofit collection law, we receive the entire amount of the bill and the collection agent is allowed to collect an additional 33% to cover their costs.)
- 6) Checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged an additional \$20 to cover paperwork and time. If a family is regularly bouncing checks, they will be required to pay in cash each month to avoid continual effort.
- 7) Families that are routinely late in paying their dues will be required to prepay (prior to the 1<sup>st</sup>) or their child or children will not be allowed to swim.
- 8) Swimmers choosing to continue to participate must inform the coach in person. If the coach is not informed, the swimmer and family may be held accountable for subsequent monthly dues.
- 9) Escrow funds will not be refunded to a swimmer leaving the team. They will be treated as a general donation to the team.
- 10) Any swimmer wishing to leave the team for any period of time will need to turn in a "SWIMMER DROP" form 2 weeks prior to following billing cycle. Whether or not the swimmer attends practice or not, without the form signed by the parent/guardian, monthly training fees will still be in affect and billed. Forms may be found on-line or in the TAC Office. If the athlete decides to return to the team, the TAC AnnualRegistration fee of \$125.00(Sept. - May) or Summer Session Registration fee of \$50.00 (June - August) must be paid again regardless of other family members who may still be swimming.
11. All "SUMMER SESSION ONLY" swimmers are required to participate in the Swim-A-Thon or pay the \$150.00 buy out. This years Swim-A-Thon will be held on June 26th at Ross Park pool.

## PART E: PARTICIPATION POLICIES

- 1) The yearly TAC membership fee and USA Swimming registration fees are nonrefundable and must be paid prior to the swimmer entering the water. Please refer to the payment schedules and fees for details.
- 2) Swim fees will be dependent on the level of the swimmer which is determined by the coach's assessment. The swim fee will not be prorated for existing or returning swimmers.
- 3) Monthly dues are to be paid by the 1<sup>st</sup> (first) day of each month. Your account becomes delinquent as of the 10<sup>th</sup> (tenth) day of the month. Each swimmer's account must be current to be eligible for swim meets.
- 4) Meet fees are due prior to participation in that meet. When a family submits a meet entry to the coach, our financial team will add their fees to their bill. These fees must be provided to the Head Coach or Team Treasurer prior to the meet. If fees are not submitted prior to the meet, the child or children will not be allowed to participate.
- 5) Should a swimmer decide to discontinue participation in the program with Tiger Aquatic Club, the monthly dues of the month for which he/she swims, any portion thereof, and any outstanding fees are considered to be due to Tiger Aquatic Club and are payable immediately upon termination.
- 6) All swimmers will abide by the disciplinary policy and we will make parents aware of infractions.
- 7) All Tiger Aquatic Club team members will be asked to sign a swimmer's 'Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Policy.' Failure to comply with the code may result in the swimmer being asked to leave the team.
- 8) Any checks returned to Tiger Aquatic Club for insufficient funds will be subject to a \$20.00 handling charge to cover TAC bank charges.
- 9) Whenever possible, the coach should be informed in advance of an illness or injury. If your swimmer will be out of the water over a long period of time with an injury or illness, please notify the Tiger Aquatic Club office (232-4366) so the coaching staff is aware of the problem.
- 10) The swimmer's family agrees to volunteer and help where needed. Tiger Aquatic Club funds its activities from two main sources. The first is the yearly registration and monthly dues you have agreed to pay. The second source is fund raising.
- 11) All swimmers are expected to participate in Fund-raising. The team shall provide a buyout fee for each fund-raising event. If a swimmer or family chooses not to participate in a fund-raising event, they may pay the buyout fee to be excused from participation. The 2009-2010 Annual Family Requirement is \$350.00 and the 2010 Summer Session Family Requirement is \$150.00. initial here:\_\_\_\_\_

# Tiger Aquatic Club Inc. (TAC)

*Note: This Code of Conduct MUST be read and signed BEFORE any swimmer will be allowed to take part in training and competition. By signing below, an acknowledgement of the contents of this Code of Conduct is made and that the swimmer agrees to abide by the same.*

## CODE OF CONDUCT

**I, the undersigned athlete, participating in training and competitions with the Tiger Aquatic Club, understand and agree to comply with the below-listed guidelines as set forth by TAC. Any additional guidelines as needed may be established by the Head Coach.**

### General Behavior

1. The transportation, possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs by any TAC team member is prohibited.
2. TAC swimmers will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, administrators, competitors, teammates and the public to include both their person and their property.
3. Illegal or inappropriate behavior that will reflect negatively on the Tiger Aquatic Club or be detrimental to performance objectives will not be tolerated.

### Travel Behavior

1. No athlete will travel when any illness is evident to the parents or coaching staff.
2. Curfews established by the staff will be adhered to each day.
3. Unless otherwise excused or instructed by a coach, participants in a team trip will attend all team functions (on time), to include meetings, practices and any other team sanctioned event.
4. There will be no male athletes in female athletes' rooms and no female athletes in male athletes' rooms.
5. Any additional guidelines will come from the staff as needed.

### IMPLEMENTATION

1. Failure to comply with these guidelines will subject the swimmer to discipline, up to and including suspension and/or dismissal from the TAC program.
2. If any failure to comply with these guidelines occurs during a travel trip or any other supervised group activity, the swimmer may be sent home at the swimmer's expense.
